

## What is Geriatrics?




- Geriatric medicine is a specialty focused on the health and well-being of older adults.
- As we age, our bodies and health needs change—geriatric medicine is designed to understand and support those changes.
- Care teams prevent, manage, and coordinate complex conditions and medications.
- The goal is to help older adults stay active, safe, and supported throughout later life.

## Geriatric Medicine in Canada

Early on, geriatric medicine wasn't recognized in Canada, and care settings were overcrowded and understaffed.

Founding physicians fought to prove older adults need specialized care and expertise.

Today, geriatrics has influenced internal medicine, surgery, family practice, and beyond.
